



GOLF GOT YOU SA TEAMBUILDING OPTIONS: (1-6)

Below I have listed various alternatives that I have available to put forward to your clients:

1)THE DRAK HERITAGE CHALLENGE/RACE:

Groups of between 10 and 20 pax (YOU DECIDED ON NO.S) are given their first clue at the commencement point: (Champagne Sports Reception)

Whereby they will need to make their way to the first location, whereby there will be a small challenge whereby they will be put through their paces with either a physical or lateral minded activity at each venue.

-There will be four to five stop off points, which will have the following activities at each venue:

Some of the activities available

-Jet-skiing on a dam ensuring that two of the members are able to complete a short course and task on the water before being able to move onto the next point.

-Clay pigeon shooting at a particular located venue

-Saddling up and riding a short distance

-Chain exercise (lateral and physical)

-10 min a side football challenge against an opposing team

-10 min Paintball challenge against an opposing team

-A quad bike challenge through a course

Right throughout the challenge groups will need to advise the driver on where the next venue is and will be required whilst on the vehicles to obtain and complete a short general knowledge questionnaire on the local area whilst on the vehicles, to keep them focused. All venues are within 15minutes max away from each other and some venues are within 5mins of each other.

This activity works on lateral, physical and fun for all, giving groups a variety of activities along route, whilst being able to view the local surrounds of the Drakensberg in an afternoon. All clues are cryptically written, and give delegates the chance to interact and work as a team. All teams will be equipped with the necessary equipment in order for them to complete all tasks.

The price of the afternoon's event works out at approx R350pp depending on what activities one requires involving and excludes vehicles hire costs.

2.)THE SPORTING EDGE:

This involves an afternoon of a selection of Sporting activities, moving teams from venue to venue which are all in close proximity, ensuring the afternoon is worked on a round-robin basis involving some of the following sports of your choice:

-Jet-skiing

-Football

-Volleyball

-Paintball

-Clay pigeon Shooting

When delegates are divided into teams of 12pax, All delegates will need to participate in the either the football, volleyball or paintball and depending on how many bonus points the team is wanting to acquire, so a maximum of two of the team-mates need to complete the Jetskiing

obstacle on water and two of the team-mates will need to complete the Clay pigeon shooting task.

Depending on your budget, so you can add or take off items accordingly, however will need to budget on R250. per person excluding vehicle transport.

3.)QUADRANGULAR:

This basic sporting afternoon involves a round-robin sporting afternoon, alternating teams between various activities (Football,Volleyball,Pitch & Putt, and rounders)R150pp

Here all teams will play in a round robin with the afternoon's activities being managed by an events team whereby results are worked out on a win and draw points basis.

4.)THE CORPORATE AGRIC GGY CHALLENGE:

The latest teambuilding event that has been recently launched is a back to basics, i.e..) This is an events teambuilding day whereby groups are taken to a local farm in the area, and are designated to complete 6 events in the quickest time. Similar to Boot Camp , just not as bad, it involves things such as Milking Dairy cows by hand in the quickest time, mucking out a stable, shearing sheep, moving irrigation pipes,crossing a river whilst using ropes etc. if you get the picture,. This is seen as a fantastic Team build and adventure challenge with a difference and something very different for those from the City, which would go down as a memorable experience for all. They are then treated to a fantastic lunch on the farm , so it's not all hard work... or can have picnic packs made up for them to have on the bus en-route in there packs or on there seats. The farm is 20minutes from the hotel and can arrange them to be picked up in cattle trucks to set the theme off right from the onset, otherwise we can use the bus route again. Prior to commencement all teams will be briefed and given the challenge that awaits them.

This due to the nature of the afternoon, works on R450 per delegate and is worked on teams and excludes the picnic charge and transport to the event.

5.)DRAK MIDLANDS CHALLENGE via SHUTTLE:

This event takes an entire full day, leaving the resort in the morning and heading through towards the Midlands Meander Route , through a series of clues. On obtaining the correct venue, there will be a task that needs completing at each designated venue of choice. One of these activities, involves Canopying through a plantation of trees, whilst viewing a spectacular natural forest. Another clue involves locating the Mandela Monument.

6.)DRAK MIDLANDS CHALLENGE VIA HELICOPTER:

Depending on the budget, I also offer the ultimate challenge which involves solving and locating destinations in the Central Drakensberg via helicopter and on locating them having to complete a fear factor challenge. This gives delegates the opportunity of viewing the Drakensberg via chopper as well as participating in a Teambuilding event.

7.)OTHER OPTIONS FOR ANOTHER EVENT OR SMALL GROUPS:

Again, as you are probably aware of, I look after all tours for spouses entering the area, and am able to keep them amused and entertained in the local area for two days, showing them all the

places of interest, as well as being able to give them a running commentary on the local area and history.

i.e.. Some of these trips include a Spouses tour (unisex) along the Midlands Meander for a couple of hours, sometimes taken as a full days tour , which could co-incide nicely with fly fishing for the gents whilst the ladies spend there time browsing and visiting sort-after spots on the meander.

I can organise guided tours of Spioenkop or take the group on a completely local historical tour covering Churchill's capture site, Ladysmith Siege, Spioenkop etc. In the event that we leave early, we could head up towards the Battle of Islandwana and Rorkes Drift, but this historical tour is entire day leaving early and returning late.

Other ideas are spending the day 4x4 riding through Weenen, about a 45minute drive from Draksun, a lovely scenic route in Darkest Africa, whilst others may like to ride through a local Game Reserve.

For your own interest, of recent I have access to a local Big 5 Game Reserve in the nearby area, which is not as yet open to the General Public and is stocked with Lion, Elephant etc. which always will now sell well for foreign clients conferencing in the Drakensberg, here we could leave early with packed breakfasts and head out for the Game-Reserve for the day.

Other ideas, if you would like to keep with the Berg theme is going on a fairly moderate hike, so all may complete, to local Bushman Paintings, whilst visiting a Bushmen Historical Center after completing the 45min there and 45min back hike.

Other ideas are booze cruises on Spioenkop after viewing the battle site, or a sightseeing drive through the game reserve, or how about a Hot Air balloon sunset or sunrise flight over the mountains instead of going via chopper, this is always a favorite, with the still silence.

Another idea, is a trip from the Central Berg into Lesotho for the day, here you enter Lesotho via the back of Bergville and is always a favorable day tour, goes without saying passports are a necessity.

Something new for the corporates, with Polo being seen as more and more as a businessman's choice of sport for business and pleasure, your clients have the opportunity to attend a day's polo clinic in the mountains, where delegates are shown the basics of the sport and are coached on quite ponies offering them the opportunity to play in a mini three on three experience. Experienced International coaches are on standby for myself in the Drakensberg when required for this clinic, to walk,talk and guide riders and non riders through the learning experience, and have had plenty of experience with coaching patrons abroad and locally.(This concept of corporate teambuilding has been very popular overseas and is something very new out here.)

Another opportunity is for clients to have the pleasure of being dropped off in the middle Berg by chopper and being escorted down with one of my guides, so there is the feeling of having hiked, however just not the cramps that go with the uphill slog of it!
